
These screenshots compare the difference between pages before and after updates. The **before** shots are production pre-update. The **after** shots are development after updates are complete but before deployed to production.

The maintenance process will not push updates to production when the ratio of pixel differences is at or above 0.1% of pixels. Deployment cannot happen until those screenshots are reviewed, approved, and then the updates are manually deployed by a human.

If you're seeing a **reason** being shown it's one of the following:

- **Performance**: Your production site loads pages much faster than the development server due to caching being enabled in production and turned off in development.
- Codecs: The page may be trying to embed things like videos that have a proprietary license and cannot be displayed through this process. Example: mp4 embeds. Side note: YouTube and Vimeo embeds will also appear broken due to unallowed loading. The space taken up is the same and doesn't mean it's broken on your site.
- Other: The reason will be given. This is a custom response for different situations that occur.


